Combined Harbour Regatta Cruiser Race Instructions v4 26 5 14 Saturday 14th June 2014 HW Portsmouth 13:00

1 RULES

1.1 The race will be governed by RRS prescriptions of the RYA, Interclub 2014 cruiser racing sailing instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

2.1 The race is open to: All mono hull Keelboats and will be sailed using The RYA Portsmouth Yardstick system.

2.2 All entrants will be invited to attend Portchester Sailing Club after sailing for the Prize giving, Live Music and a BBQ.

3 SCHEDULE

3.1 Racing will start at 11:45 off Portchester Castle, Warning Signal will be at 11:40.

3.2 All entrants must sign on to race by calling Portchester Race Control on VHF CH 37/M1 no later than 5 minutes before the warning signal.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 The Course letter will be broadcast to all competitors on VHF CH37 / M1 no later than 5 minutes before the warning signal.

4.3 Section 8 "Time Limit" of the 2014 Interclub Cruiser Sailing instructions is amended for this race so that the time limit is 2hr 30 minutes. However, where the first boat finishes within this time limit then the limit will be extended by a further hour to 3hrs 30 mins .

Start Line: a line between a committee boat flying an orange flag located off Portchester Castle and an inflatable buoy.

Finish Line: an imaginary line between the black and Yellow post on the front of Portchester SC start hut and Pile 76 (Green) and onwards

Course Z:

As defined by the race committee and broadcast on VHF Channel 37 10 minutes before the scheduled start time

- N.B After the Start competitors must stay on the channel side of all channel markers except those in Portchester Lake north of Pile 80 and except where the course instructions specify otherwise.
- Forton Lake is a yellow admiralty buoy located SE of the end of the Radar Pier at Priddys Hard
- Pounds buoy is the 1st of a series of mooring buoys in mid channel heading from Portsmouth to Portchester approximately between piles 89 & 90.
- Admiralty 2 is the first yellow admiralty mooring buoy when turning starboard on leaving Portchester lake between pile 57 (Red) and pile 95 (Green)
- Admiralty 1 is the 2nd yellow admiralty mooring buoy when turning starboard on leaving Portchester lake between pile 57 (Red) and pile 95 (Green)
