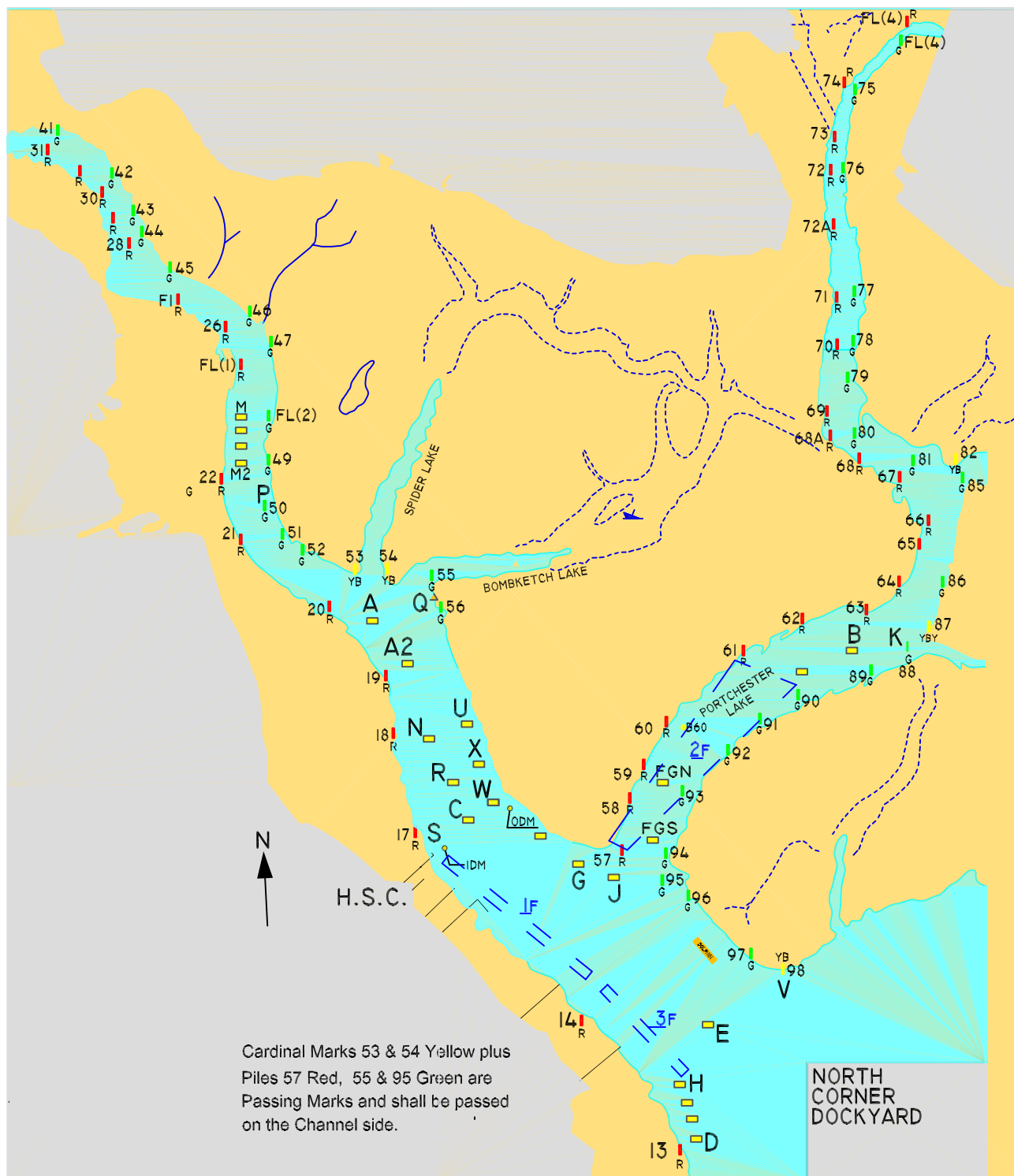


COURSE CHART RACING MARKS

- A. Northernmost buoy (5th) of West Trot
- A2. Bouy South of (A West Trot)
- B. Last Admiralty buoy in Portchester Creek
- B60. Rusty buoy near Pile 60
- C. 1st Admiralty buoy of West Trot
- D. Southern most buoy B/T Trot, East of Burrow Island
- E. No. 3 Admiralty buoy
- F. HSC inflatable mark
- G. Admiralty buoy Portchester Entrance, SW of Pile 57
- H. Northern most buoy B/T Trot, East of Burrow Island
- J. Admiralty buoy Portchester Entrance, South of Pile 57
- K. Pile 88 Green Portchester Creek (H.W. only)
- L. Inflatable laid in BombKetch Lake
- M. Northernmost buoy Frater 'C' Trot
- M2. Southernmost buoy Frater 'C' Trot

- N. 3rd Admiralty buoy of West Trot
- P. Pile 50 Green (shallow at L.W.)
- Q. Club Laid Mark
- R. 2nd Admiralty buoy of West Trot
- S. HSC yellow buoy (**Also IDM**)
- U. Small Admiralty buoy near cable pile
- V. Pile 98 Use mid tide to high water (not on falling tide)
- W. Southernmost buoy of West Trot
- Y. Club Mark laid in harbour
- Z. Inflatable laid in Spider Lake
- FGN. Foul grounds North Portchester Creek
- FGS. Foul grounds South Portchester Creek
- IDM. Bouy S to be passed on the **CHANNEL SIDE**
- ODM. Bouy to be passed on the **CHANNEL SIDE**
- Area's 1F, 2F & 3F may be used for club laid marks.
