



Heavily constructed GRP - Built: 1974 – Moored at Hardway Sailing Club

LOA – 32ft

Beam: 9ft

Draft 4ft 6ins

Stainless steel rigging replaced in 2007- sails laundered regularly. Hank-on foresail arrangement but Rotostay self-furling equipment and genoa available (both bought 2nd hand and never got-around to fitting).

5 berths, (double forward, 2x saloon berths plus 1 x quarterberth)

TAYLORS paraffin two burner cooker with oven. TAYLORS paraffin cabin heater.

Twin s/steel galley sinks. Coolbox. Cockpit table,

LAVAC heads.

Good sized chart table. Standard Horizon Chartplotter, Garmin GPS, Simrad VHF, Navtex

Permanent low-profile maststeps fitted above spreaders. Also has facility for full length removable maststep-ladder arrangement –(requires mainsail removal and then mast step ladder is led up mast track).

Beaching legs (adjustable aluminium and fit into sockets permanently mounted on either side).

Recent upgrades include:

- 1) Hull topsides professionally repainted 2014
- 2) Re-engined in 2014 with Lister LPW3 30HP Diesel - including new prop and sterngear
- 3) Aries Windvane Selfsteering (effortless long distance sailing with no power consumption)
- 4) Saloon berths re-upholstered and new carpet installed on cabin sole 2014
- 5) New sprayhood, dodgers and sailcover in 2016

A substantial yacht that can comfortably handle heavy weather (competed in Round the Island in 2011 and 2016 – both coincidentally relatively heavy weather years –finished 3rd in class in 2016.
